Ladies Day Guidelines

- Play is from the <u>Green Tees</u>
- Live Scoring on Golf Genius is mandatory.
- In addition to Live Scoring, some games will require scorecards to be handed into the Pro Shop. If needed, this will be noted in your weekly tee time email.
- <u>Gimmes</u> may be taken within <u>1 putter grip length</u> (approx. 12 inches) from the front edge of the hole and counted as one stroke. To encourage pace of play, <u>once a Gimme is accepted by</u> the player you MUST pick up your ball and advance to the next tee.
- Maximum Scoring Per Hole is Par +5.
 - On a par 3 the maximum stroke count will be 8.
 - On a par 4 the maximum stroke count will be 9.
 - On a par 5 the maximum stroke count will be 10.
 - If the maximum score on a hole is reached, you MUST pick up your ball and proceed to the next tee.
- If you have not reached the Maximum Scoring Per Hole as listed above, your unadjusted actual gross score is to be recorded for each hole, including temporary holes
- Certain games will be required to be holed out this will be stated on game day.
- All Ladies Day scores will be posted to Golf Canada by the Pro Shop unless otherwise stated.
- Winning results will be posted online and through the Club House app under Ladies
 Day/Weekly Results, as well as on the glass showcase bulletin board located at the Pro Shop

Live Scoring - Golf Genius

- Live Scoring on Golf Genius is mandatory on all Ladies Day events unless noted otherwise.
- All players should have the Golf Genius App downloaded onto their cell phones.
- One person in each group is to be designated to enter gross scores into Golf Genius <u>for the entire group</u> using a code provided by the Pro Shop.
- This code will be included with your tee time confirmation.
- Individuals should also keep track of their own gross scores for comparison and verification

May 6

International Par Points

- o Points will be awarded by the Pro Shop on each hole for Gross and Net Scores as follows:
- o 1-Bogey, 2-Par, 4-Birdie, 6-Eagle, 8-Double Eagle.
- o Must hole-out all putts, no gimmes allowed.
- o Winners will be determined based on the <u>highest par points score.</u>
- Prizes for best High Gross and High Net scores.

Score Classification: RESTRICTED

May 13

Criss Cross

- Choose your best score from Holes 1 or 10; 2 or 11; 3 or 12, etc.
- Your final score will be a total of these 9 holes less ½ of your handicap.
- The Pro Shop will determine your best holes for your final score.
- Prizes for best Low Net Scores.

May 20

Team Rotation

- o Each team will consist of three or four players.
- After choosing a starting player for Hole 1, rotate through your Team for the next holes and continue this same rotation throughout the round.
- One player's score is to be counted for the Team on each hole.
- On the scorecard, mark down the selected player's gross score on the respective hole played.
- The total of all 18 holes will be your team score.
- o In addition to Live Scoring, <u>scorecards are required</u> and must be handed into the Pro-Shop.
- Team prizes for best Low Net Scores.

May 27

3 Jills & A Jack - Spring Shotgun/Lunch

- o Teams will consist of 3 Jills & 1 Jack (3 Females & 1 Male).
- o Ladies are permitted to select their own teammates.
- The "Jack" selected for your team cannot be a spouse or partner of any fellow team members.
- A "Jack" list will be provided through the Pro Shop.
- o The format will be a Step-Aside Scramble:
 - All players tee off on each hole.
 - The player whose shot is chosen will not play the next shot and he/she will "Step Aside".
 - Play continues in this format for each shot until you are on the green.
 - Once on the green, all players are permitted to putt from the selected shot.
- Must hole-out all putts, no gimmes allowed.
- o In addition to Live Scoring, <u>scorecards are required</u> and must be handed into the Pro-Shop.
- A "team" handicap will be determined for Gross and Net prizes.
- o Shotgun Start with Lunch and Prizes to follow.
- A \$30 meal charge will be applied for each person attending.
- o Team prizes for best Low Gross and Low Net Scores in addition to individual proxies.

June 3

Play with a Pro

- o Pro's will play a designated number of holes with each group throughout the round.
- You can ask questions and get tips as you play.
- o Prizes for Low Gross and Low Net Scores.

June 10 & June 17

President's Cup

- Sign-up for Day 1 or Day 2 or Both.
- O NOTE: YOU MUST BE A LADIES DAY SEASONAL PREPAID MEMBER IN ORDER TO PARTICIPATE IN THE PRESIDENT'S CUP ON EACH DAY.

Score Classification: RESTRICTED Page 2 of 5

DROP-IN PARTIPATION IS NOT PERMITTED FOR THIS EVENT

- Day 1 Regular tee times.
- Day 2 Shotgun Start followed by Lunch & Prizes.
- o Must hole-out all putts, no gimmes allowed for both days.
- o Players will be grouped into flights based on their handicaps.
- Handicaps will be determined approximately two days prior to Day 1 of the competition and will be frozen at that handicap for those participating in both days.
- Players will remain in their original flight for the entire competition and will not be moved on Day 2.
- Prizes awarded for Low Gross and Low Net for each day as well as for a combined 2-Day total.
- A trophy will be awarded to the Low Gross winner.
- o Lunch sign-up will be required and a \$30 meal charge will be applied for those attending.
- When registering, please indicate if you will be attending the lunch/prize presentations on Day 2.

June 24

Putts, Nutts & Gutts

- Count your Putts.
- o Total score will consist of your Putts plus your Net (Nutts) and Gross (Gutts) scores.
- Keep track of your gross score and your putts Pro Shop will calculate total final scores.
- o Must hole-out all putts, no gimmes allowed.
- o In addition to Live Scoring, <u>scorecards are required</u> and must be handed in to the Pro-Shop.
- Prizes for best Low Gross and Low Net Scores.

<u>July 1</u>

Bargain Day

- o Regular game of golf with scoring on Golf Genius.
- The Pro Shop will determine the worst score on two holes on front nine and two holes on the back nine for each player and convert them into pars.
- Prizes for best Low Net Scores.

July 8

HOST Visitation Day

- Sturgeon will be hosting <u>Edmonton Golf Club</u>.
- This will be a shotgun start followed by a luncheon and prizes.
- Lunch sign-up will be required and a \$30 meal charge will be applied for those attending.
- o A separate pre-determined meal charge will be applicable for the Visiting Club.
- o Further details will follow.

July 15

Team Best Ball

- 2-Person Teams will be randomly created by the Pro Shop for a 2-Person Best Ball format.
- Each player on the team plays their own ball throughout the round.
- The lowest score on each hole counts as the team's score for that hole.
- o In addition to Live Scoring, scorecards are required and must be handed into the Pro-Shop.
- Team prizes for best Low Gross and Low Net scores.

<u>July 22</u>

Tic-Tac-Toe

- Two Tic-Tac-Toe grids with Holes 1-9 on one grid and Holes 10-18 on another grid, will be provided by the Pro Shop.
- o If you score a Net Par or better on a hole, you mark an X on the corresponding grid.
- At the end of the round, count how many X's make a straight line and note the number of straight lines you have at the top of your grid card.
- Prizes for the players with the most XXX lines.

July 29

Best of the Best

- o Circle 3 each of your Best Par 3, Par 4, and Par 5 scores.
- Subtract 1/2 of your handicap from the nine holes you circled to obtain your Net score.
- o In addition to Live Scoring, <u>scorecards are required</u> and must be handed into the Pro-Shop.
- Prizes for best Low Net Scores.

August 5

AWAY Visitation Day

- We will be visiting <u>Riverside Golf Club</u>. Details will follow closer to the event date.
- o Tee times (or shotgun) will be determined by the Host Club.
- Sign-up for lunch will be required. A pre-determined meal charge will be set by the Host Club.
- This meal charge will be charged to your Sturgeon Account and forwarded to the Host Club.
- o If utilized, power cart rentals may be paid for at the Host Club's Pro Shop.
- Our Drop-In Fee (paid at AWAY) will apply.

PLEASE NOTE: Ladies not attending the Away Visitation will be able to sign up for our usual Ladies Day tee times at Sturgeon for a day of "Just Golf". There will be no Ladies Day game or prizes scheduled on this day.

August 12

Ladies Member Guest Invitation Day

- o Invite your Guest to play a free practice round prior to our next day's Member Guest Tournament.
- o Two-Person Team format.
- o Prizes for both Member and Guest proxies.

August 19

Skins

- 2 Handicapped Flights will be created. Gross and Net skins will be counted.
- The player with the lowest score on a hole wins the "skin".
- o If there is a tie, the skin is carried over and accumulates until the next lowest score is made.
- Prizes for number of Low Gross and Low Net skins won.

August 26

Tombstone

- o Each player will receive a Tombstone marker from the Pro Shop.
- When your score, less your handicap, totals 72 you lose your Tombstone.

Score Classification: RESTRICTED

- Place your Tombstone in the ground <u>beside the green</u> on the hole that you met your demise.
- o Anyone who keeps their Tombstone for the entire round and hands it in receives a prize.

<u>September 2 & September 9</u>

Team Eclectic

- PICK YOUR OWN PARTNER or sign up as a single and the Pro-Shop will create teams from all single entrants for this game that extends over two weeks.
- o Each week the best individual low gross and low net score on each hole is kept.
- After Game 2 the lowest low gross and lowest net score between both days on each hole is the team score.

September 16

Hidden Partner

- o Each player will be assigned a Hidden Partner by the Pro Shop.
- Prizes for best Team Low Gross and Low Net scores.

September 16 Ringer Board Cutoff

- This will be the last day to record Ringer Board achievements.
- Each Personal Best hole <u>must</u> have either a cross or a recorded written score for each hole in order to be eligible for prizes.
