

2026 Ladies Day Detailed Schedule of Games

Register weekly up to 7 days in advance on-line through the Member Calendar or in the Pro Shop.

Cut-Off will be Friday Midnight prior to playing day

Draws will be created, posted in the Pro Shop and emailed prior to each game

Ladies Day Guidelines

- Play is from the Green Tees
- Live Scoring on Golf Genius is mandatory.
- In addition to Live Scoring, some games will require scorecards to be handed into the Pro Shop. If needed, this will be noted in your weekly tee time email.
- Gimmes may be taken within 1 putter grip length (approx. 12 inches) *from the front edge of the hole* and counted as one stroke. To encourage pace of play, **once a Gimme is accepted by the player you MUST pick up your ball and advance to the next tee.**
- Maximum Scoring Per Hole is Par +5.
 - On a par 3 the maximum stroke count will be 8.
 - On a par 4 the maximum stroke count will be 9.
 - On a par 5 the maximum stroke count will be 10.
 - If the maximum score on a hole is reached, you MUST pick up your ball and proceed to the next tee.
- If you have not reached the Maximum Scoring Per Hole as listed above, your unadjusted actual gross score is to be recorded for each hole, including temporary holes
- Certain games will be required to be holed out – this will be stated on game day.
- All Ladies Day scores will be posted to Golf Canada by the Pro Shop – unless otherwise stated.
- Winning results will be posted online and through the Club House app under Ladies Day/Weekly Results
- Unexpected sign-ups or adjustments received after the cut-off or on Ladies Day may result in some groups being modified to accommodate these changes.
- Please adhere to the tee times you are assigned in order to keep the schedule running as smoothly as possible.

Live Scoring – Golf Genius

- *Live Scoring on Golf Genius is mandatory on all Ladies Day events unless noted otherwise.*
- All players should have the Golf Genius App downloaded onto their cell phones.
- One person in each group is to be designated to enter gross scores into Golf Genius for the entire group using a code provided by the Pro Shop.
- This code will be included with your tee time confirmation.
- Individuals should also keep track of their own gross scores for comparison and verification purposes with the group's scorer after the game.

May 12

International Par Points

- Points will be awarded by the Pro Shop on each hole for Gross and Net Scores as follows:
- 1-Bogey, 2-Par, 4-Birdie, 6-Eagle, 8-Double Eagle.
- Must hole-out all putts, no gimmes allowed.
- Winners will be determined based on the highest par points score.
- Prizes for best High Gross and High Net scores.

May 19

Odds Out, Evens In

- Players only count the odd numbered holes on the front nine and even numbered holes on the back nine.
- This would give everyone a 10-hole score.
- Front nine: 1, 3, 5, 7, 9
- Back nine: 10, 12, 14, 16, 18

May 26

3 Jills & A Jack - Spring Shot Gun/Lunch

- Teams will consist of 3 Jills & 1 Jack (3 Females & 1 Male).
- Ladies are permitted to select their own teammates.
- The "Jack" selected for your team cannot be a spouse or partner of any fellow team members.
- A "Jack" list will be provided through the Pro Shop.
- The format will be a Step-Aside Scramble:
 - All players tee off on each hole.
 - The player whose shot is chosen will not play the next shot and he/she will "Step Aside".
 - Play continues in this format for each shot until you are on the green.
 - Once on the green, all players are permitted to putt from the selected shot.
- Must hole-out all putts, no gimmes allowed.
- In addition to Live Scoring, scorecards are required and must be handed into the Pro-Shop.
- A "team" handicap will be determined for Gross and Net prizes.
- Shot Gun Start with Lunch and Prizes to follow.
- A \$35 meal charge will be applied for each person attending.
- Team prizes for best Low Gross and Low Net Scores in addition to individual proxies.

June 2

Rotation Game

- For each group the one best score would count for the team.
- If your score is used for that hole, you cannot have your score used for the following hole, you would choose from the other players in the group.
- This might require strategy in deciding what score to use if the next hole is a par 3 or a par 5.

June 9

Play with a Pro

- Pro's will play a designated number of holes with each group throughout the round.
- You can ask questions and get tips as you play.
- Prizes for Low Gross and Low Net Scores.

June 16 & June 23

President's Cup

- Sign-up for Day 1 or Day 2 or Both.
- **DROP-IN PARTICIPATION IS PERMITTED FOR THIS EVENT**
- Registration fees for those ladies who are drop in will be \$25.00 per day.
- Day 1 - Regular tee times.
- Day 2 – Shot Gun Start followed by Lunch & Prizes if enough ladies are registered, if not then it will be regular tee times.
- Must hole-out all putts, no gimmes allowed for both days.
- Players will be grouped into flights based on their handicaps.
- Handicaps will be determined approximately two days prior to Day 1 of the competition and will be frozen at that handicap for those participating in both days.
- Players will remain in their original flight for the entire competition and will not be moved on Day 2.
- Prizes awarded for Low Gross and Low Net for each day as well as for a combined 2-Day total.
- A trophy will be awarded to the Low Gross winner.
- A \$35 meal charge will be applied for all Day 2 Registrants.
- When registering, please indicate if you will be attending the lunch/prize presentations on Day 2.

June 30

Tombstone

- Each player will receive a Tombstone marker from the Pro Shop.
- When your score, less your handicap, totals 72 you lose your Tombstone.
- Place your Tombstone in the ground beside the green on the hole that you met your demise.
- Anyone who keeps their Tombstone for the entire round and hands it in receives a prize.

July 7

HOST Visitation Day

- Sturgeon will be hosting Belvedere Golf & Country Club.
- This will be a Shot Gun start followed by a luncheon and prizes.
- Lunch sign-up will be required, and a \$35 meal charge will be applied for those attending.
- A separate pre-determined meal charge will be applicable for the Visiting Club.
- Further details will follow.

July 14

6-6-6 Game

- The round is divided into 3 different formats:
 - First 6 holes: Best Ball
 - Second 6 holes: Scramble
 - Third 6 holes: Alternate shot
- This will be played as a partner game, the computer will pick the teams

July 21

Away Visitation Day

- SVGCC Ladies will be visiting the Stony Plain Golf Club
- For those not attending away visitation day, regular tee times will be available to book as usual. No prizes on this day.

July 28

Mystery Holes

- Players record all scores normally.
- There will be 6 holes randomly preselected on Golf Genius
- Only those holes will be counted

Aug 4

Tic-Tac-Toe

- Two Tic-Tac-Toe grids with Holes 1-9 on one grid and Holes 10-18 on another grid, will be provided by the Pro Shop.
- If you score a Net Par or better on a hole, you mark an X on the corresponding grid.
- At the end of the round, count how many X's make a straight line and note the number of straight lines you have at the top of your grid card.
- Prizes for the players with the most XXX lines.

August 11

Ladies Member Guest Invitation Day

- Invite your Guest to play a free practice round prior to our next day's Member Guest Tournament.
- Two-Person Team format.
- Prizes for both Member and Guest proxies.

August 18 & 25

Team Eclectic

- **PICK YOUR OWN PARTNER or sign up as a single and the Pro-Shop will create teams from all single entrants** for this game that extends over two weeks.
- Each week the best individual low gross and low net score on each hole is kept.
- After Game 2 the lowest low gross and lowest net score between both days on each hole is the team score.

Sept 1

Skins

- 2 Handicapped Flights will be created. Gross and Net skins will be counted.
- The player with the lowest score on a hole wins the "skin".
- If there is a tie, the skin is carried over and accumulates until the next lowest score is made.
- Prizes for number of Low Gross and Low Net skins won.

Sept 8

Best of the Best

- Circle 3 each of your Best Par 3, Par 4, and Par 5 scores.
- Subtract 1/2 of your handicap from the nine holes you circled to obtain your Net score.
- In addition to Live Scoring, scorecards are required and must be handed into the Pro-Shop.
- Prizes for best Low Net Scores.

September 15

Gift Game

- 4 Random holes are pre-selected to win a prize
- Scoring for this day is as normal, lowest score on the preselected holes will win a prize. In case of a tie there will be a putt off.

September 15 Ringer Board Cutoff

- **This will be the last day to record Ringer Board achievements.**
- **Each Personal Best hole must have either a cross or a recorded written score for each hole in order to be eligible for prizes.**

September 22

Final Ladies Day of the Season – Proxy Extravaganza – Invite a Guest

Ladies Wind-Up Supper and Awards – Tentative date - **All SVGCC Lady Members Welcome!**
